TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The tournament will be conducted by the Decatur Heritage Christian Academy Athletic Booster Club. Interpretation of these rules shall be left exclusively to the tournament officials.
2. Tournament hours will be from safe daylight to 3:00 p.m. (First Flight.) All contestants and boats must depart from launch site and must return by boat to that landing no later than the end-of-tournament time. Any contestant's boat returning after the end-of-tournament time will be considered late. Any late contestant's boat will be penalized 1 pound/minute and disqualified after 15 minutes. Late is Late.
3. Rules will be read prior to the tournament start. One partner from each boat must be present.
4. All fish brought to the weigh-in (except trophy bass) will be returned to the water after weigh-in. There will be a 5 fish limit per boat.
5. The tournament officials reserve the right to disqualify questionable fish (iced, damaged, etc.)
6. Only largemouth, smallmouth and spotted bass will be weighed – a one pound penalty will be assessed for each and every fish measuring less than 12 inches. An 8 ounce penalty will be assessed for each and every fish delivered to weigh station dead. These penalties will reduce the total weight of the contestant's catch.
7. All ties will be split.
8. Only artificial lures will be permitted; however, pork type baits may be used.
9. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the boat or at the weigh-in site during the tournament.
10. No trolling, live bait or fishing within 50 yards of another tournament boat. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times. Any disorderly conduct will be ample reason for a contestant's disqualification from the tournament.
11. Contestants will wear a life jacket and will have a kill switch (when main motor is so equipped) attached to person or driver whenever the main motor is running.
12. All live wells and boats will be inspected prior to the start of the tournament. A LIVEWELL CHECK VERIFICATION RIBBON will be issued to each boat.
13. Contestants will abide by all Alabama water safety standards.
14. Single fishermen are allowed.
15. NO HOLE SITTING.
16. It will be an expressed condition that all prize winners be subject to a polygraph test, administered by a licensed polygraph tester, and must pass the test in order to win the prize.
17. I understand that officials of this event have the right to postpone this event due to weather or other safety related considerations. Rain date scheduled for March 24, 2012.
18. Any condition arising which is not covered by the above rules will be resolved by the tournament officials (to be announced during reading of the rules), whose decision will be final.
